ELIGIBILITY

Eligibility varies depending on the Apprentice qualification, but as a minimum we typically look for five GCSE's, grade C /grade 4 and above, including English and Maths.

LEVEL 4 CONSTRUCTION PROGRAMME

With this two year Apprenticeship, you can complete a Level 4 qualification in Construction. During this time, you'll complete placements in key areas of the business, before choosing to specialise in either Quantity Surveying or Construction Management in your final year.

Once complete, you will then progress onto our three year, Level 6 (degree) programme in Quantity Surveying or Construction Management, resulting in your degree certification.

The programme is delivered in through a mixture of practical workplace experience and study which means you get the best of both worlds – a taste of university life and work! Each study block typically lasts four weeks and you'll attend a minimum of two blocks per academic year.

Due to the nature of this Apprenticeship, it would suit school / college leavers from 18 years of age. Get in touch if you would like to learn more about eligibility for this programme.
